Sister Phoebe Commended

16 I commend to you P h o e b e our sister, who is a servant of the church in C e n c h r e a,² that you may receive her in the Lord in a manner w o r t h y of the saints, and assist her in whatever b u s i n e s s she has need of you; for indeed she has been a helper of m a n y and of myself also.

Greeting Roman Saints

³Greet P r i s c i l l a and Aquila, my fellow w o r k e r s in Christ Jesus,⁴ who risked their own n e c k s for my life, to whom not only I give thanks, but also all the churches of the G e n t i l e s.⁵ Likewise *greet* the church that is in their h o u s e.

Greet my beloved E p a e n e t u s, who is the firstfruits of A c h a i a to Christ.⁶ Greet M a r y, who labored much for us.⁷ Greet Andronicus and J u n i a, my countrymen and my fellow p r i s o n e r s, who are of note among the apostles, who also were in C h r i s t before me.

⁸Greet Amplias, my b e l o v e d in the Lord.⁹ Greet U r b a n u s, our fellow worker in Christ, and Stachys, my beloved.¹⁰ Greet Apelles, a p p r o v e d in Christ. Greet those who are of the h o u s e h o l d of Aristobulus.¹¹ Greet Herodion, my c o u n t r y m a n. Greet those who are of the *household* of N a r c i s s u s who are in the Lord.

¹²Greet Tryphena and Tryphosa, who have l a b o r e d in the Lord. Greet the beloved Persis, who labored much in the L o r d.¹³ Greet Rufus, chosen in the Lord, and his m o t h e r and mine.¹⁴ Greet Asyncritus, Phlegon, Hermas, Patrobas, Hermes, and the b r e t h r e n who are with them.

¹⁵Greet Philologus and Julia, Nereus and his s i s t e r, and Olympas, and all the s a i n t s who are with them.



¹⁶ Greet one another with a h o l y k i s s. The c h u r c h e s of Christ greet you.

Avoid Divisive Persons

¹⁷ Now I u r g e you, brethren, note those who cause d i v i s i o n s and offenses, contrary to the d o c t r i n e which you learned, and a v o i d them. ¹⁸ For those who are such do not s e r v e our Lord Jesus Christ, but their own b e l l y, and by smooth words and f l a t t e r i n g speech deceive the hearts of the s i m p l e. ¹⁹ For your o b e d i e n c e has become known to all. Therefore I am glad on your behalf; but I want you to be w i s e in what is good, and simple concerning e v i l. ²⁰ And the God of peace will crush S a t a n under your feet shortly. The g r a c e of our Lord Jesus Christ *be* with you. Amen.

²¹ T i m o t h y, my fellow worker, and Lucius, Jason, and Sosipater, my countrymen, g r e e t you.

²² I, Tertius, who wrote *this e p i s t l e*, greet you in the Lord.

²³ Gaius, my h o s t and *the h o s t* of the whole church, greets you. Erastus, the t r e a s u r e r of the city, greets you, and Quartus, a b r o t h e r. ²⁴ The grace of our Lord Jesus Christ *be* with you all. Amen.

²⁵ Now to Him who is able to e s t a b l i s h you according to my gospel and the preaching of Jesus Christ, according to the revelation of the m y s t e r y kept secret since the world began ²⁶ but now made manifest, and by the p r o p h e t i c Scriptures made known to all nations, according to the commandment of the e v e r l a s t i n g God, for obedience to the faith— ²⁷ to God, alone wise, *be g l o r y* through J e s u s C h r i s t forever.
