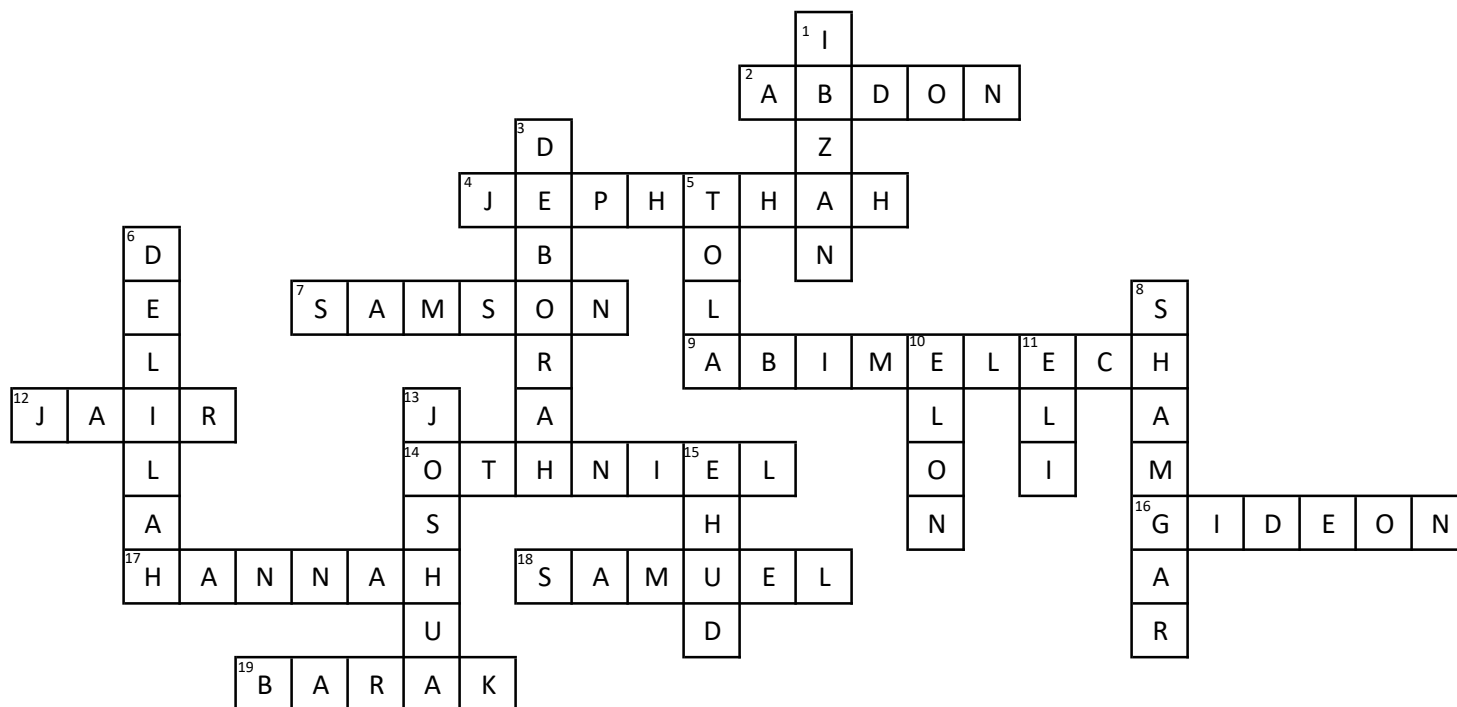


# Judges of Israel Crossword - Answers

## Across

- 2 The eleventh judge of Israel judged for 8 years. He had 40 sons and 30 grandsons. (Judges 12:13-15)
- 4 The eighth judge was a Gileadite and mighty warrior. He trusted God and was victorious over the Ammonites. (Judges 11)
- 7 The twelfth judge of Israel who was a Nazirite from birth and had great strength. He judged for 20 years and defeated many Philistines until a woman he loved tricked him. (Judges 13-16)
- 9 This man was not a judge but the men of Shechem made him king. He ruled for 3 years and did evil things. (Judges 9)
- 12 The seventh judge was a Gileadite who judged for 22 years. He had 30 sons who rode on 30 donkeys and had 30 cities. (Judges 10:3-5)
- 14 He was the first judge and the younger brother of Caleb. He went to war for the people and judged for 40 years. (Judges 3:9-11)
- 16 God was with this mighty man of valor. The Lord led him and an army of 300 men to defeat the Midianites. (Judges 6-8)
- 17 This woman prayed desperately for a child. When God gave her a child, she named him Samuel and dedicated him to the Lord. (1 Samuel 1)
- 18 The fourteenth and last judge of Israel was dedicated to the tabernacle when he was a child by his mother, Hannah. He also anointed the first kings of Israel, Saul and David.
- 19 He was not a judge, but he led 10,000 men with judge Deborah to destroy the army of Sisera (Judges 4)

- 1 The ninth judge of Israel was from Bethlehem and had 30 sons and 30 daughters. He judged for 7 years. (Judges 12:8-10)
- 3 She was the fourth judge of Israel and the only female judge. She heard the people's problems under a palm tree and judged them for 40 years. (Judges 4-5)
- 5 The sixth judge was a man of Issachar who lived in Ephraim. He ruled for 23 years. (Judges 10:1-2)
- 6 The woman who Samson loved who tricked him into telling her that shaving his head would make him weak. (Judges 16)
- 8 We don't know how long the third judge of Israel served, but we know he killed 600 Philistines with an ox goad (Judges 3:31)
- 10 The tenth judge of Israel was a Zebulunite who judged for 10 years. (Judges 12:11-12)
- 11 The thirteenth judge of Israel had sons that were wicked before the Lord. This man judged for 40 years and trained up Samuel.
- 13 This leader died at age 110. After he and the elders of the time died there arose a generation who did not know the Lord's work and they turned to other gods (Judges 2:6-10)
- 15 The second judge of Israel who killed King Eglon with a sword then judged for 80 years (Judges 3:12-30)



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
